Now we have implemented an environmental management system we are committed to operating our business responsibly and in compliance with all environmental regulations, legislation and approved codes of practice relating to our activities. It is our objective to operate with, and to maintain good relations with all regulatory bodies.

It is Guarantor Security's declared policy to carry out all measures reasonably practicable to meet, exceed or develop all necessary or desirable requirements and to continually improve environmental performance through the implementation of the following:

- 1. Assess and regularly re-assess the environmental effects of the organisations activities
- 2. Assess and regularly re-assess the organisations environmental objectives and targets
- 3. Training of employees in environmental issues
- 4. Minimise the production of waste
- 5. Minimize material wastage
- 6. Minimize energy wastage
- 7. Promote the use of recyclable and renewable materials
- 8. Reduce and/or limit the production of pollutants to water, land and air
- 9. Control noise emissions from operations
- 10. Minimise the risk to the general public and employees from operations and activities undertaken by the organisation

This policy is communicated to all employees, suppliers and sub-contractors and is made available to the public.

In drafting and reviewing the Environmental Policy all personnel involved ensured that it:

- 1. Is appropriate to the nature, scale and environmental impacts of its activities
- 2. Includes a commitment to continual improvement and the prevention of pollution
- 3. Includes a commitment to comply with the relevant environmental legislation and regulations, and with the other requirements to which the Organisation subscribes
- 4. Provides the framework for setting and reviewing environmental objectives and targets
